Declaration on the use of conflict commodities

Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act

Dear Sir or Madam,

With this letter we affirm that the products of Janitza electronics GmbH do not contain any conflict commodities from the Democratic Republic of Congo or neighboring regions.

According to the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and the Consumer Protection Act of 2010, the conflict commodities are gold, tin, tantalum and tungsten, which are mined in the above-mentioned regions under inhumane conditions. As a manufacturer of electronic devices, we are affected by these raw materials.

The company is aware of its social responsibility towards the environment and the health and human rights of others and is committed to transparency in the supply chain.

In order to ensure transparency in our supply chain, we have once again consulted with our suppliers, all of whom are well-known manufacturers. They have informed us that the raw material sources of their products lie outside the conflict regions and do not contribute to the financing of an armed conflict in the Democratic Republic of Congo and neighboring regions.

Our knowledge at the present time confirms that we use no conflict commodities for our products. We assure you that we will continue to deal sensitively with this topic in the future in order to ensure that our data remains up to date.
